### Honourary Memberships

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT

1. Pursuant to Article 7.1 of By-law No.1, the Board of Directors creates a class of members titled Honourary Members.
2. Pursuant to Article 7.1(a)(C) of By-law No.1, individuals designated as Honourary Members, including designations by predecessor organizations, will have all the rights and privileges of Voting Members.

#### Criteria

3. An individual who has rendered *long and meritorious* or *extraordinary* service to a Canadian Military College or the RMC Alumni Association is eligible for the award of an honorary membership.

#### Process

4. Any Branch that has been recognized pursuant to Article 9 of By-law No.1 or any member of the Board of Directors may nominate an individual for the award of an honorary membership.
5. A nomination should be accompanied by a letter of recommendation supporting the nomination that describes how the individual has rendered *long and meritorious* or *extraordinary* service to a Canadian Military College or the RMC Alumni Association.
6. Nominations should be submitted to the CEO no later than August 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
7. Nominations will be considered by a sub-committee composed of a minimum of three directors of the Board that will make a recommendation, in consideration of the exceptional nature of the recognition, to the Board for consideration at its September meeting.

#### Implementation

8. Nominations approved by the Board will be announced at the first Annual General Meeting following the Board meeting at which they were approved.
9. Where an individual who is already a member of the RMC Alumni Association is awarded an honorary membership, then the prefix 'H' will be attached to that person's College Number or Membership Number. Where an individual who is not a member of the RMC Alumni Association is awarded an honorary membership, that person will be assigned a membership number with the prefix 'S'.
